Show Cards will be furnished for numbering and identification.

Passes - One owner/exhibitor pass will be allotted to each entry. Additional exhibitor passes, valid for the duration of the show, will be available for \$20.00. Limit one additional pass per entry.

Stanchions & Rope will not be furnished. We ask that all bike owners furnish their own to improve the appearance of their display and to best protect your vehicle. Unauthorized advertising in display areas is not allowed.

Fire Regulations require locking gas caps, taped gas caps or tanks must be drained. All displays must be free standing and composed of fireproof materials. All battery cables must be disconnected. Fire aisles must be kept open at all times.

Entry For Sale - Any entry for sale will charged a fee of \$50 to be paid at time of registration. This fee includes a Starbird-Devlin Rod & Customs Charities Car Show For Sale sign and is the only approved For Sale sign allowed.

Sound or PA Systems - No Sound Equipment Allowed in display areas. Failure to comply will result in bicycle(s) removal and complete disqualification.

Time Schedule - Set-up will occur from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. Thursday, January 19. (Deadline for pre-registered entry check-in is 8:30 p.m. Thursday.) It is important the move-in times be maintained to allow safe efficient parking and setup. Entrants will enter Century II along Douglas Ave. The bicycle competition will be held in the balcony at Century II's Exhibition Hall. This is the northern most hall along Douglas Ave.

To Enter - Send your entry form and other correspondence to the address above. You will be notified of your acceptance in letterform. Photos will be returned when possible. The show reserves the right to refuse any entry. All pre-registered entries must move-in on Thursday. It is important the move-in times be maintained. (At-the-door entries will be accepted based on space availability.)

The awards selection process at the Starbird-Devlin Rod & Customs Charities Car Show is designed to honor and highlight a wide variety of bicycles. The Starbird-Devlin Rod & Customs Charities Car Show is about the passion people have for their vehicles. In our opinion every bicycle deserves an award for all the hard work that has gone into your creation. Remember, it's not all about getting an award. Enjoy the event and make some new friends who have the same enthusiasm you do for our hobby and lifestyle. If you get an award it's icing on the cake of a great weekend! The bicycle awards ceremony will be held on Sunday, January 22 at 4 p.m. in Convention Hall.

Contest Classes – Since some bicycles can fit into several different classes, each builder must decide in which class the bicycle will compete. However, the judges will finalize all classifications prior to judging. First place trophies will be awarded in each class.

Classes – There will be twelve classes in which you can enter. The classes are 1) Original, 2) Ladies, 3) Custom, 4) Rat Rod, 5) Boys Junior (16 and under), 6) Girls Junior (16 and under), 7) Schwinn, 8) Chopper, 9) Tandem, 10) Low Rider, 11) Muscle, and 12) Skip Tooth. There will also be four specialty awards given for Best Display, Best Patina, Best Paint, and Best of Show.

Number of Entries – Your \$20.00 entry fee will allow you to enter up to four bicycles under one entry. If you would like to enter more than four bikes, you must submit a second entry and will cost another \$20.00 for up to four more bicycles.
